Any Bidder willing to take part in the process of e-Tendering will have to be enrolled & registered with the Government e-Procurement System through logging on to <https://wbtenders.gov.in>. The Bidder is to click on the link for e-Tendering site as given on the web portal.

ii. Digital Signature Certificate (DSC):

Each Bidder is required to obtain a Class-II or Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for submission of tenders from the approved service provider of the National Informatics Centre (NIC) on payment of requisite amount. Details are available at the Website <https://wbtenders.gov.in>. DSC is given as a USB e-Token. The Bidder can search & download N.I.T. & BOQ (Bill of quantity) electronically from computer once he logs on to the website mentioned above using the Digital Signature Certificate. This is the only mode of collection of Tender Documents.

iii. Submission of Tenders:

Tenders are to be submitted online to the website in two folders at a time for each tender (one is Technical Proposal & the other is Financial Proposal) before the prescribed date & time using the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). The documents to be uploaded should be virus scanned copy duly Digitally Signed. The documents will get encrypted (transformed into non-readable formats).

SECTION-A: INTRODUCTION & OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

1. Introduction

The West Bengal Electronics Industry Development Corporation Limited (WBEIDC), incorporated in 1974, is the nodal agency of the Government of West Bengal (GoWB) for overall development of Information Technology (IT), Electronics and Information Technology enabled Services (ITeS) industries in the State of West Bengal. It is under the administrative control of Department of Information Technology and Electronics (DITE), Government of West Bengal. WBEIDC has been spearheading all the digital progression in the State.

WBEIDC Limited on behalf of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation seeks proposal from eligible Bidders for Scanning & Digitization of Inspection Book Records and implementation of Cloud Based Document Management Software and hosting of the application in a Govt empaneled Cloud.

2. Objective of the Project

The project envisages digitization of Inspection Books of KMC. The inspection books are bound registers, having information related to properties. High end colour book scanners only shall be used to capture the images. Metadata indexing will have to be done for the property records. A cloud based application software needs to be developed and hosted. The software will be accessed by authorized users to search and retrieve the property records and the scanned images. Existing digitized property records of KMC also will have to be incorporated in the newly developed application to complete the database.

SECTION - B: INSTRUCTION TO BIDDER

In this document, the following terms shall have following respective meanings:

"Agreement" means the Agreement to be signed between the successful firm and West Bengal Electronics Industry Development Corporation (WBEIDC) Limited including all attachments, appendices, all documents incorporated by reference thereto together with any subsequent modifications, the RFP, the bid offer, the acceptance and all related correspondences, clarifications, presentations.

"Bidder" means the firm who applies the tender **"Contract"** is used synonymously with Agreement.

"Deliverables" means the documents as mentioned in this RFP

"Default Notice" shall mean the written notice of Default of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other.

"Fraudulent Practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a Contract and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after Bid submission) designed to establish Bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the WBEIDC LTD. and eventually Govt. of West Bengal of the benefits of free and open competition.

"Law" shall mean any Act, notification, by law, rules and regulations, directive, ordinance, order or instruction having the force of law enacted or issued by the Government of India and/or the Government of West Bengal or any other Government or regulatory authority or political subdivision of government agency.

"LOI" means issuing of Letter of Intent shall constitute the intention of the WBEIDC LTD. to place the Purchase Order with the successful firm.

"Services" means the work to be performed by the Bidder pursuant to this Contract, as described in the detailed Scope of Work.

1. Submission of BID

Bids are to be submitted online to the website stated earlier in two folders at a time, one is Techno Commercial Proposal & the other is Financial Proposal, before the prescribed date & time using the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). Only the Digitally Signed documents are to be uploaded after proper virus scanning. The documents will be encrypted (transformed into non-readable formats).

2. Cost of Bidding

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid. WBEIDC LTD. shall not be responsible for these costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

3. Bid Document

Bidders to examine all instructions, forms, terms and requirement in the bid document. The invitation to bid together with all its attachment thereto shall be considered to be read, understood and accepted by the bidder. No deviations will be accepted. Failure to furnish all information required by the bid document or a bid not substantially responsive

to the bid document in every respect may result in rejection of the bid, subject to the discretion of tender evaluation committee

4. Amendment of Bid Document

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of proposals, WBEIDC LTD. reserves the right to add/modify/delete any portion of this document by issuance of a Corrigendum, which would be published on the website. The Corrigendum shall be binding on all bidders and will form part of the bid documents. Corrigendum can be published at least 3 days prior to the last date of Bid submission, with extension of 4 days of bid submissions deadline, such that the bidders gets at least 7 days to submit the bid after a corrigendum is published.

5. Modification and Withdrawal of Bids

The bidder may modify or withdraw its bid after submission, before the deadline prescribed for bid submission.

6. Language of Bid & Correspondence

The proposal will be prepared by the Bidder in English language only. All the documents relating to the proposal (including brochures) supplied by the firm should also be in English, and the correspondence between the Bidder & WBEIDC LTD. will be in English language only. The correspondence by e-mail must be subsequently confirmed by a duly signed formal copy.

7. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

The Bidder shall pay EMD through net banking or through RTGS/NEFT in the portal of the website: <https://wbtenders.gov.in> as per G.O 3975-F(Y) dated 28th July 2016 issued by Finance Department, Govt. of West Bengal. For details regarding payment procedure & guideline on the same, bidders are advised to follow the mentioned order and portal.

8. Forfeiture of EMD

EMD by Bidder may be forfeited under the following conditions:

- If Bidder withdraws the proposal before the expiry of bid validity period.
- During the evaluation process, if a Bidder indulges in any such activity as would jeopardize the process .The decision of WBEIDC LTD. regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon for explanation under any circumstances.
- If Bidder violates any of the provisions of the terms and conditions of the proposal.
- In the case of successful Bidder, if Bidder fails to:
 - a) Accept the work order along with the terms and conditions.
 - b) Furnish performance security.
 - c) Abide by any of the work conditions of this proposal or indulges in any such activities as would

jeopardize the work.

- d) Ensure submitting false/misleading information/declaration/documents/proof/etc.

The decision of WBEIDC LTD. regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon to any explanation under any circumstances.

EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the signing of LoA with the successful bidder.

9. Forms and Formats

The various inputs for the Technical as well as Price bid are to be submitted in the format specified. The bidder shall use the form, wherever specified, to provide relevant information. If form does not provide space for any required information, space at the end of the form or additional sheets shall be used to convey the said information. For all other cases, the bidder shall design a form to hold the required information.

10. Lack of Information to Bidder

The bidder shall be deemed to have carefully examined the Bid document to his entire satisfaction. Any lack of information shall not relieve the bidder of his responsibility to fulfil his obligation under the bid. If bidder has any queries related to bid document then they can send the queries before/during the Pre Bid Meeting.

11. Evaluation Procedure

- Bidders who have submitted the valid Bid Security, i.e., EMD, Tender Document Fee & NIT Declaration (Annexure – 12) as per requirement shall be considered as pre-qualified for further evaluation. Absence of these pre-qualifying documents may lead to rejection of the bid.
- The Eligibility Criteria (Annexure – 3) will be evaluated by Tender Committee and those who qualify will be considered for further evaluation.
- The Tender Committee would perform the Technical Evaluation of the bidders who qualified the eligibility criteria as per the tender document. Bidders securing a minimum of **70 marks** in the Technical Evaluation will only be considered for Price Bid evaluation.
- Price bid will be opened for evaluation only for those bidders who have technically qualified.
- The Successful Bidder will be decided on **“L-1 Basis”**
- The quoted cost will be firm for the entire duration of the project.

12. Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)

Within 14 days of notifying the acceptance of proposal for the award of contract, the successful bidder shall furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) from an Indian nationalized bank, as per Annexure-11, amounting to the 10% of the total bid value for the entire contract period as its commitment to perform services under the contract.

PBG should be valid for the contract period and 90 days beyond the contract end date. Bidder may be asked to extend

the PBG according to project progress.

Failure to comply with the requirements shall constitute sufficient grounds for the forfeiture of the PBG. The PBG shall be released after expiry of contract provided there is no breach of contract on the part of the bidder. No interest will be paid on the PBG.

13. Signing of Agreement

WBEIDC LTD. will award the contract to the bidder as per the evaluation process stated in the tender.

14. Liability

In case of any default on bidder's part or other liability, WBEIDC LTD. shall be entitled to recover damages from the firm. In each such instance, regardless of the basis on which WBEIDC LTD. is entitled to claim damages from the firm (including fundamental breach, negligence, misrepresentation, or other contract or tort claim), firm shall be liable for no more than:

- Payment referred to in the Patents and Copyrights clause.
- Liability for bodily injury (including death) or damage to real property and tangible personal property limited to that cause by the firm's negligence.
- As to any other actual damage arising in any situation involving non-performance by firm pursuant to or in any way related to the subject of this RFP, the charge paid by WBEIDC LTD. for the individual product or Service that is the subject of the Claim.
- However, the firm shall not be liable for any indirect, consequential loss or damage, lost profits, third party loss or damage to property or loss of or damage to data or for any direct loss or damage that exceeds the total payment for Contract Price made or expected to be made to the firm hereunder.

15. Patents & Copyright

If a third party claims that a product delivered by the firm to WBEIDC LTD. under this project, infringes that party's patent or copyright, the firm shall defend WBEIDC LTD. against that claim at firm's expense and pay all costs, damages, and attorney's fees that a court finally awards or that are included in a settlement approved by the firm.

16. Governing Laws

This contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with Laws in force in India. The courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the contract. The firm shall keep himself fully informed of all current national, state and municipal law and ordinances. The firm shall at their own expense, obtain all necessary permits and license and pay all fees and taxes required by law. These will be firm's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement.

17. Termination for Default

In case the performance of firm is deemed unsatisfactory (manifested in delays, lack of quality, unavailability of resources, and lack of results/outcomes as expected and agreed) the client reserves the right to issue a letter of concern in case of dissatisfaction with selected bidder's work. Selected bidder may be asked to submit clarifications or a reply regarding the same. In case of incomplete/delayed/dissatisfactory response or if the concerns are not adequately addressed, the client reserves right to issue letter of dissatisfaction to the firm stating the reasons. On issuance of two or more such letters of dissatisfaction, the client (WBEIDC LTD.) reserves the right to terminate the contract by issuing a 30 days' notice period to the firm. In such eventuality WBEIDC LTD. will invoke the amount held back from the firm as PBG. Decision of WBEIDC LTD. in this regard will be final and abiding without any prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract for the firm.

18. Jurisdiction Clause

Jurisdiction of the engagement would be limited only to courts in Kolkata.

19. Arbitration Clause

In case of any disputes, the arbitrator may be selected based on mutual agreement between the client WBEIDC Ltd. and the successful firm.

20. Force Majeure

It is hereby defined as any cause, which is beyond the control of the firm or WBEIDC LTD. as the case may be, which such party could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as

- War, Hostilities or warlike operations (whether a state of war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy and civil war.
- Rebellion, revolution, insurrection, mutiny, usurpation of civil or military, government, conspiracy, riot, civil commotion and terrorist activity.
- Confiscation, nationalization, mobilization, commandeering or requisition by or under the order of any government or de facto authority or ruler, or any other act or failure to act of any local state or national government authority.
- Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo, import restriction, port congestion, lack of usual means of public transportation and communication, industrial dispute, shipwreck, shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plague.
- Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear disaster and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.

If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances

of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.

The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure upto its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfil its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.

No delay or non-performance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall.

- Constitute a default or breach of the contract.
- Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or non- performance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or non-performance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure

21. Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices

The Tender Committee requires that the bidders under this Tender observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. For this purpose the definition of corrupt and fraudulent practices will follow the provisions of the relevant laws in force.

The Tender Committee will reject a proposal for award if it detects that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.

The Tender Committee will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract.

22. Binding Clause

All decisions taken by the Tender Committee regarding the processing of this tender and award of contract shall be final and binding on all parties concerned. The Tender Committee reserves the right:

- To vary, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above and,
- To reject any or all the Tender/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision

23. Grafts, Commissions, Gifts, etc.

It is the Purchaser's policy to require that the bidder under contracts, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. Any graft, commission, gift or advantage given, promised or offered by or on behalf of the firm or any one on his or their behalf in relation to the obtaining or to the execution of this or any other contract with WBEIDC LTD. Shall in addition to any criminal liability which it may incur, subject the firm to

the cancellation of this and all other contracts and also to payment of any loss or damage to WBEIDC LTD. Resulting from any cancellation. WBEIDC LTD. Shall then be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from any monies otherwise due to the firm under contract.

24. Enforcement of Terms

The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provision of this contract or any rights in respect thereto or to exercise any option here in provided shall in no way be construed to be a waiver to such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect the validity of the contract. The exercise by either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have hereunder.

25. Period of Validity of Offer

For the purpose of placing the order, the proposals shall remain valid till 180 days from bid submission date. During the period of validity of proposals, the rates quoted shall not change.

26. Taxes & Duties

- **The prices quoted shall be exclusive of all taxes, applicable GST rates are also to be mentioned in the commercial bid format. Total Price of the Bid will be auto-calculated.**
- Deduction of all statutory and necessary Tax from each bill will be made as per Government Order prevailing at the time of payment. Necessary tax deduction certificate will be issued on demand by the Company.
- Bidder submitting a tender shall produce up to date, Income Tax and Profession Taxes Certificate as well as the GST certificate issued by the concerned Tax Authority or a Certificate that the assessment is under consideration. All such clearance certificates shall remain valid on the last date of submission.

27. Discrepancies in Bid

Discrepancy in the amount quoted by the bidder due to calculation mistake of the unit rate then the unit rate shall be regarded as firm.

28. Late Bid

Late bid shall not be accepted by WBEIDC LIMITED.

29. Contacting WBEIDC LTD.

Bidder shall not approach WBEIDC LTD. officers beyond office hours and/or outside WBEIDC LTD. office premises from the time of the Bid opening to the time of finalization of successful bidder. Any effort by bidder to influence WBEIDC LTD. office in the decision on Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or finalization may result in rejection of the Bidder's offer. If the bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of WBEIDC LTD., it should be in writing.

30. WBEIDC LTD's Right to reject any or all Bids

WBEIDC LTD. reserves the right to reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

31. Bid Currencies

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees, inclusive of all prevailing taxes, levies, duties, cess etc.

32. Price

Price should be quoted in the Price Bid (BOQ) format only. SECTION-E: SCOPE OF WORK

A. Functional Requirements Overview

The project envisages digitization of Inspection Books of KMC. The inspection books are bound registers. When the register is opened both left and right side pages contain information related to same properties, therefore high end colour book scanners only shall be used to capture image of both right and left side pages simultaneously and saved as a single image. Size of left and right side pages together shall be A3 size. Each such image can have records related to two properties demarcated by horizontal line, sometimes there is entry of one property because of length of text. There are hand written text in colour inks as well as pencil. Colour scanning shall be required and scanning resolution/quality will be such that no information is lost.

KMC is presently having 11,58,000 approx scanned IB Images, starting from 1/1984. The scanning was done in the year 2014-15. These images are in .jpg format. A search and retrieval software also exists developed in Java and the indexing database is in Oracle.

1. Fresh scanning under the present scope (**approximately 2.0 lakhs images**) is required for IB Records of 4/1983 and earlier and also of Inspection Books (IBs) which were made and matured after 2014-15 and upto date.
2. Cloud hosting and cloud facility to be provided.
3. A Cloud based application needs to be developed so that Scanned IB images of Inspection Books could be stored in cloud and could be downloaded by designated and authorized users.
4. Presently 200 numbers of users from 7/8 different locations of Assessment Collection Offices of KMC will access and retrieve the scanned documents. 10 more non-KMC users may also be allowed to access and view these scanned IB images.
5. Restricted access need to be given users for downloading the scanned images of IB Copies. Downloaded images should be saved as .pdf format.
6. **Receiving the IBs** - Keeping records of IBs received from KMC department for scanning in a log register along with IB number, no. of pages etc. After collecting the IBs, it will be responsibility of the vendor to maintain and return the documents in their original form. The IBs shall be cleaned before scanning if required.
7. A total of approximately 2.0 lakhs pages of IB records need to be scanned afresh under the present scope. The IB registers are retained at 7 KMC premises which are HQ at Dharmotolla and offices at Gariahat, Baghajatin, Santoshpur, Taratolla, Garden-Reach and Joka.
Address of Seven different Assessment Collections offices headed by corresponding Assessor Collectors (AC) are as follows:-
 - Assessor Collector (N) & Assessor Collector (S) : 5 S.N. Banerjee Road, Kolkata 13.
 - Assessor Collector (TTD) : Gariahat Market, 212 Rashbehari Avenue, Kolkata 19.
 - Assessor Collector (JU), Br-XI : Baghajatin Market Complex, Unit-I, Kolkata 92.
 - Assessor Collector (JU), Br-XII : Santoshpur Avenue, KMC Super Market, Kolkata 75.
 - Assessor Collector (SSU) : 1 Diamond Harbour Road, Kolkata 38.
 - Assessor Collector (GRU) : E-3 Circular Garden Reach Road, Kolkata 24.
 - Assessor Collector (Joka) : 4 Diamond Park, Joka, Kolkata 104.
8. The IBs are bound registers, if bindings of documents are required to be removed / loosen during the process of scanning then the books are to be returned with proper binding.

9. Size of documents to be scanned is: A3, consisting of two successive pages side by side of the bound register.
10. Colour scanning is required to exactly replicate information page/record.
11. **Collection of Meta Data indexing** - A format shall be created for capturing the administrative and descriptive metadata of the IBs being scanned, for each KMC Inspection Book. The successful bidder shall have to fill in the metadata (Assessee No., GR / IR, Quarter (GR/IR), IB Information (IB No, Page No etc). The firm also need to migrate data from MAS (Municipal Administration System) application wherein some other details of the assessee like Office Code, Ward No, Street code, Premises No, Owner name, Owner address, contact No etc. as metadata. The metadata tags should be alphanumeric, in English.
12. **Scanning of Documents** - About approximately 2.0 lakh pages shall be scanned in JPEG format with resolution of 300 dpi or higher. Color scanning is required as Inspection Books are written on different colours and with pencil also bearing different meaning. The scanning shall be undertaken using technically compatible instruments / scanners at the 6 different Assessment Collection offices / units of KMC across the city. All the documents/pages need to digitized and no pages / documents shall be digitized more than once. Final images will be required both in jpg as well as pdf format.
13. **Quality Control** – Dedicated workstation and staff shall be deployed to ensure quality control (QC) of the scanned documents. Amongst other things, the QC operator shall check and verify the no. of pages being scanned, sequence of pages, image quality of the document and verification with original document to ensure 100% accuracy. Image enhancement activities like De-skew (to make images straight), contrast ratio setting etc have to be done. Cropping and cleaning of images like removing black noises around the text, de-sparkle (removing small dots between the texts). In case the documents are not legible, the documents need to be scanned on higher resolution.
14. In the situation of rejecting any page due to any reason the system should be capable of capture the reason for rejecting the same from the operator and this information shall be available and intimated to the rescanning station for future use meaning for re-scan etc. and only rejected records will be flagged and will be stored in file server. Separate report MIS will be generated.
15. The system should display the information about the rejected documents by image QC which is to be rescanned. System shall have the capability of image assisted Data Entry with zooming in and zooming out facility.
16. The data to be retrieved by matching only the assessee no. if the data is not found, KMC will be notified through report.
17. Random sample of the scanned data of IBs will be validated by KMC personnel, which will be displayed in a screen of the software application.
18. No information from the documents or original contents should get erased or overwritten or lost in the process of cleaning the data. Final scanning figure would be on actual basis.

B. Software development

1. The Software shall be developed using technology appropriate for Maintenance, Version Control and Online Viewing of the scanned Inspection Books and other documents. Source Code of the existing software developed in Java / Oracle is available. The successful bidder can develop fresh software or if they choose to work on the existing codes and incorporate further additions /

modifications the existing codes can be made available. The present scope of work includes indexing of the newly scanned images (approx. 2.0 lakhs) and migration / inclusion of the existing index information and completion of the indexing work of 11.58 lakhs existing images in the new Software. Existing 11.58 images are in .jpg format. They need to be converted to pdf format also as part of the present project.

2. The application software should have provision for
 - Data entry of additional features, Access Key Definitions etc. for each document during scanning.
 - Role based access. The system must facilitate management of users and users access right and privilege.
 - Mechanism to search the document based on user defined Queries, parameters, Document identity etc.
 - View, printing and download facility.
 - Scope for entry of additional data.
 - The application software should be web enabled and should be stored in CLOUD.
3. The document should be scanned and stored with unique document identification (will be decided by department).
4. Software should be ready at the time of Proof of Concept (POC). Data of one Ward should be taken for POC. POC should be shown by vendor within one month of issuing work order.
5. The search engine shall allow the retrieval of records using the meta-data fields such as Assessee No., Office Code, Ward No., Street Name, Premises No., GR / IR, Effective Quarter etc. The search engine shall be available on the KMC intranet as a web based online solution, using which authorized users can search and navigate through the list of the digitized documents. The software shall have an access and authorization mechanism and shall enable authorized users to download non-editable copies of a document. While downloading there should be facility to download jpg original file and also provision for automatic conversion to pdf during downloading.
6. The vendor should design the application software package using latest available tools and technologies, standard etc. The application should have web enable module to display the scanned data. The web module should be developed in Java platform.
7. The software should facilitate adding scan data in a progressive manner, post implementation, while in use by the user. Facility to backup and restore the complete data without loss to be provided without redoing the whole process. Software should have clear scope of Fresh Scanning, Conversion to .pdf format, Uploading, Indexing facility so that KMC Users can them-self scan, index and upload the images of freshly created IB records (in future) on this cloud based application software.
8. Appropriate data compression techniques should be used by the vendor to minimize / optimize the storage space, without compromising the system performance and time for retrieval of information.
9. The system should be able to generate output in hard copies as well as softcopies.
10. Once a document is scanned, it should not be able to be removed from the archived data by any unauthorized person. An appropriate work flow for approval at suitable stage be incorporated for deletion of such data.
11. The search engine and version control software shall have an Administration module which can

be used by the System Administrator to carry out the routine administrative tasks such creating new user, granting of viewing / new entry permissions, checking of log files, changing hardware and software configuration etc.

12. The development of the search engine and version control methodology shall be followed within the pilot project phase. An SRS document for the above software must be submitted to KMC for vetting and approval before the software is developed.
13. The application shall be hosted in a Govt empaneled Cloud Service Provider (CSP). The bidder shall quote for such hosting and maintenance services for one year. The CSP shall meet MeitY (Ministry of Electronics & IT, Govt of India) empanelment criteria and should be certified for ISO 27001 and 27018. The CSP should have accreditation relevant to security, availability, confidentiality, processing integrity, etc. The servers should be physically present in the country. CSP environment and services shall be STQC audited and shall be valid at the time of bidding.
14. **Training and Demonstration** – The selected firm shall be responsible for providing adequate training of the new software to the users (KMC employees). It shall provide onsite support, training and demonstration at Six different Assessment Collection Offices on an as-needed basis during the project duration.
15. **Documentation** - The selected firm shall develop exhaustive documentation (viz. SRS, user manual, technical manual, etc.) of the software development that it undertakes. While writing code for any software, it shall adhere to coding standards (with ample and appropriate commenting, version control, etc.)
